Health

Health forms are due PRIOR to your sons arrival at camp every summer. It requires Parent and Physician signatures as well as a copy of an Insurance card. If your doctors appointment is later, please send the first 3 pages signed by a parent now and send the physical form (pg 4) once it is signed by your doctor.

Spending Money

Deerhorn recommends that each camper be given a check for \$25 per week to use for trips, stamps, film, gatorade, snacks, and other sundry supplies purchased in the camp store. The check should be made payable to the camper and will be deposited in the camp bank. Please do not include spending money in the tuition check. The balance in each boy's account will be sent to him after he departs camp. The purchase of Deerhorn clothing is optional and can be pre ordered and paid for directly to the Deerhorn Trading Post.

Deerhorn is not responsible for valuables brought to Camp. Do not send cell phones or computers!

Baggage, Laundry and Lost & Found

Please ensure all baggage has camper's name on the outside. No Ice Hockey equipment will be allowed on the bus from Chicago. Please send it UPS. Oversize trunks cannot be accommodated in the koogees (cabins). A small foot locker is recommended (13"H x 20"D x 32"L). Weekly laundry service is provided for each camper at no cost and the turn around time is less than one day. A large laundry bag is required. Please conspicuously mark every item with permanent ink including shoes, racquets, helmets, flashlights, sheets, etc. Deerhorn can not be responsible for articles left at camp or lost during the season. The amount of unmarked lost & found items each year is enormous! Deerhorn will provide bedding and towels for campers from foreign countries at no extra charge.

Safety

While Deerhorn has an exemplary safety record and is well known for its competent and compassionate staff, we can never put too many safeguards in place when it comes to your children. Please make sure your son knows that he should contact a Broadbridge if he ever has a concern that his counselor has not rectified. It is strictly forbidden for boys to have ammunition, arrows, matches, flammables, firearms, weapons, pocket knives or knives of any kind in their possession. Your child should know that whatever is not allowed at school, is not allowed at camp.

Leaving Camp

Deerhorn will not allow any boy to leave camp with another boy's visiting parents unless he first has written permission from his own parents. You must send the enclosed permission slip if you wish for your son to leave camp with visitors. Boys will not be allowed to call home for "spur of the moment" permission.

Visiting Camp

Parents are invited to visit anytime but are required to check in at the office. Please let us know in advance when you will be arriving to ensure that your son is not out of camp on a trip. **Please do**

not bring your dogs to camp. Please do not ask other campers to leave with you if they do not have permission or you do not have enough seat belts. Deerhorn is not able to accommodate parents or siblings in our cabins, dining room, or activity classes.

For those who plan to visit camp the weekend of July 10-13, we must advise that this is the annual Hodag Country Music Festival weekend held near Rhinelander and rooms will be almost impossible to find.

Care Packages

Mail is distributed every evening. Please do not send food, candy, gum, squirt toys, or water balloons to camp. All packages containing food of any description will be labeled with the boy's name and given to him the day he departs camp. Please do not allow your son to bring food or candy to camp. Snacks can be purchased after lunch.

Sunday Services

Catholic campers may attend Mass in Rhinelander each Sunday. Please let Deerhorn know in advance, in writing, if you wish for your son to attend. If we do not hear from you about this, it will be your son's decision. All campers attend our nondenominational "inspirational message" service on Sundays.

Correspondence

Because our phone lines are so busy, we ask that you please not call your son unless it is an emergency or a special occasion, such as a birthday. If you have questions, you can call a camp director or counselor between 9AM and 6PM. The best way to correspond with your son is via the U.S. Mail and he will be required to do the same twice each week. (Pre-stamped, & addressed envelopes are recommended, especially for younger campers.) Campers are able to receive email at camper@deerhorn.com for a charge of \$1.00 each. Campers "last name, first name" must appear in the subject line and no attachments are accepted.

Optional In-Line Skating

Deerhorn provides roller hockey sticks, pucks, and helmets, but we do not provide skates or protective equipment. Any boy bringing in-line skates to camp **MUST** also bring a fitted mouth guard, elbow and knee pads, and wrist guards. Use of this protective gear is mandatory.

Deerhorn Memories

Directions to Deerhorn from Rhinelander

After you arrive in Rhinelander, proceed to the East side of town and you will find the intersection of Business 8 and Highway 17 North Bypass (located by the Wal-Mart). Turn North on the 17 North Bypass and go to the second stop light. (You will see the Rhinelander Ice Arena) This will be County Highway C. Turn right and go seven miles until you see the Deerhorn sign. Turn right on Deerhorn Road and go two miles into camp.
